Whitby Town

Botham's, Baxtergate, Whitby. Café on ground and first floor. Level access from street, but limited space on ground floor due to layout. Excellent cream cakes and light lunches. Toilets situated upstairs. Telephone: 01947-602823.

Botham's, Skinner Street, Whitby. Same cream cakes etc., but also do full lunch, daily specials. Stair lift to restaurant on first floor, with a wheelchair provided at the top of the stairs. Closed Mondays during winter. Telephone: 01947-602823

Passage to India, 29 Windsor Terrace, Whitby. Ground floor award winning licensed restaurant and takeaway. South Indian cooking. Vegetarians catered for. Items not on menu may be prepared on request. Level access from street. Accessible toilet on ground floor. Open from 5.30pm weekdays, from 12 noon weekends. Telephone: 01947 606500/ 606489.

Royal Fisheries (Fuscos), 48 Baxtergate, Whitby. Award winning family run fish and chip shop and adjacent licenced café. One high step in to takeaway. Assistance bell located outside on doorway. Ramped access into café. Ground floor toilet facility in café. Open Mon to Thurs 11.30am to 8pm; Fri 11.20am to 10pm; Sat 11.20am to 8pm (Café closes 7pm). Both Cafe and Takeaway are open later during High Season, and Sundays from Easter to September. Telephone 01947 825346.

The Angel Hotel (Wetherspoons), 1 New Quay Road, Whitby, YO21 1DH. Harbourside hotel and pub in one of the oldest hotel buildings in town. Pub food menu. Specials available. Themed menu nights. Opening times Mon – Fri 7am to midnight, Sat - Sun 7am to 1am. Seating and tables on ground floor, and via lift to first floor. Accessible toilet on ground floor. Dogs not permitted inside. The Magpie Café, 14 Pier Road, Whitby. Famous fish restaurant in Whitby town centre. Wheelchair access via lift located in adjacent takeaway. Gluten free diets catered for. Long queues particularly in summer. Telephone: 01947 602058

Whitby Abbey & Visitor Centre, Abbey Plain, Whitby. Overlooking Whitby town, on the east side. Accessible café and toilets. Telephone: 01947 603568.

Whitby Museum & Art Gallery, Pannett Park, Whitby. Parking for disabled drivers only. Wheelchair access via back door of museum (door entry system). Café on lower ground floor. Access via lift between floors. Accessible toilets on each floor, Building closed Mondays. Telephone: 01947 602908
